Procedures:

A. Halloween Countdown: Stickers For National Pumpkin Day

B. Walk In Song- Requiem in D minor, KV 626

C. Physical Warm-Up

- a. "Follow the Leader" stretches to Blinding Lights

D. Vocal Warm-Up

- a. Breathing: More breathing rhythms with accents and articulations.
 - i. Breathing to letter D.
- b. Vowel Sound Building/ Dynamic: Nee Voo Nee Voo
- c. Attaching sound to air: Lip trill to eee and then to ahh.

E. Repertoire

a. And So It Goes

1. Review second set of ooo's, with piano, no met, VERY SLOW
2. On solfege, everytime you go to new solfege syllable, do motion.
3. Add met 52, and motion.
4. Make sure they're aware of the differences in the second set.
5. Remove the piano and met it.
6. Add on the next section, with spoken rhythm. (25-33) (8th)
7. Put together with ooo's.
 - a. Cleaning:
 - b. Take away piano and have them draw phrase that I provide.
 - c. Take away music and memorize up through ooo's

b. Rytmus

1. Start at Letter C.
2. Learn 67-68, review letter D.
3. Alto and tenor first
4. Tonal pattern soprano and bass.
5. Feel section in 2 or 3.
6. Part by part, build up and review the counting for letter D.
7. Go back to A and go through.
8. Review m. 77 (B Major section) with a slower tempo.

c. Unclouded Day

1. Start page 9 review up to made of gold.
2. Beginning to there.
3. Sing from the beginning through page 12, try to lock the next part, and learn till the end of the song, similar to the beginning.
